In this role, you'll get to work with a supportive team to deliver immediate trauma-informed and person-centred care to flood affected communities. You will use your experience to provide brief interventions and case manage participants in a holistic manner for optimal outcomes.

You will have demonstrated experience in delivering mental health and/or suicide prevention service, providing trauma informed care and case management for persons with complex support needs.
