The LEAG comprises 10-12 people with alcohol and other drugs and mental health services experience who advocate for meaningful change at The Buttery.

You will be paid to attend monthly meetings, in person or via phone or video link. The first meeting is planned for September 2023.

## The LEAG partners with The Buttery to:

- · Provide feedback and expertise on issues related to people living with substance use and/or mental health concerns, their family members, kin and supporters.
- · Provide information and advice to inform service development.
- Ensure lived experience of substance use and/or mental health concerns informs the work of all The Buttery services.

## Who is eligible to apply for the Lived **Experience Advisory Group?**

## People over 18 years of age who:

- Have a lived experience of alcohol and other drug and/or mental health issues.
- · Have accessed any of The Buttery services in the last 5 years.
- Are a family member, carer or kin of someone who has accessed or tried to access any of The Buttery services in the last 5 years.

- Prepared to contribute to meeting discussions and communications.
